

LEGACY SERVICE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Required Vendor Documentation

1. RDB Certificate
2. VAT Certificate
3. Company Profile
4. Public Liability Insurance (Renewed Copy)
5. Legal Certification
6. Other Licenses, Insurance Policies, or Requirements as Mandated by Applicable Local Laws

Terms and Conditions

1. Prices quoted in the bid shall remain firm for the duration of the contract from the date of acceptance and issuance of a purchase order, if applicable. No price increases will be permitted regardless of changes in market rates or requirements.
2. The Management reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, in whole or in part, without assigning any reason and is not obligated to accept the lowest quotation.
3. The Management reserves the right to award one or more items or categories to different bidders as deemed appropriate.
4. All quoted rates must be exclusive of taxes. Applicable taxes, customs duties, freight, and related charges must be stated separately.
5. The Management reserves the right to terminate the contract upon thirty (30) days written notice without providing a reason.
6. Quantities/specifications stated are estimates and may increase or decrease without prior notice. The bidder shall supply revised quantities at the quoted rates.
7. Failure to supply services as requested may result in procurement from alternative sources, with any excess costs charged to the defaulting bidder.
8. The bidder shall not offer, promise, authorize, or provide any payment, gift, or other benefit to influence any employee, officer, or representative of the Management.
9. Payment terms: Sixty (60) days from receipt of a valid invoice.
10. The successful bidder may be required to execute a separate agreement with each hotel covered by the bid, in a form acceptable to the respective hotel.



11. Bidders must comply with Marriott-approved service specifications.

ANTI-BRIBERY AND ANTI-CORRUPTION CLAUSE

1.1 The Supplier shall comply with all applicable laws, statutes, regulations, and codes relating to anti-bribery and anti-corruption.

1.2 The Supplier shall not engage in bribery or corrupt practices, including facilitation payments, involving private parties, political entities, candidates, or public officials.

1.3 The Supplier shall not offer, request, authorize, receive, or provide any financial or other advantage intended to improperly influence decisions or conduct.

1.4 Any suspected illegal, corrupt, or non-compliant conduct must be reported immediately to the Operator, and the Supplier shall follow the Operator's instructions regarding such matters.

1.5 The Operator may request supporting documentation and audit compliance with this clause. The Supplier shall provide all requested information, including compliance certificates.

1.6 The Supplier agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Operator and its affiliates against any claims, losses, or liabilities arising directly or indirectly from a breach of this clause.
