Background:

This role is central to implementing impactful Health and WASH initiatives, while also strengthening youth education in Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH) and Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM).

1.WASH/Health Project Coordinator 1(Location: GNI Head Office, Kigali – Rwanda)

Key Tasks and Responsibilities:

- a) Implement and deliver on approved GNI 2026 Plan of Action (POA) ensuring transparent and accountable budget execution.
- b) Organize and conduct meetings with Health Clubs, and water users' committees to monitor activities, address challenges, and propose way forward.
- c) Take overall responsibility for the implementation of WASH/Health projects at both Head Office and Area Office levels.
- d) Prepare and submit timely reports (weekly, monthly, quarterly, annual) to the Operations Department (OD) Manager.
- e) Support the OD Manager in developing new projects and ensuring their successful implementation.
- f) Conduct regular field visits and stakeholder meetings to monitor progress and procedures.
- g) Ensure proper filing of office and project documents, and safeguard office equipment and materials.
- h) Integrate child protection principles in all project activities and ensure children are protected from any form of harm.
- i) Submit project-related receipts on time.
- j) Maintain confidentiality of organizational information during and after service.
- k) Perform other tasks as assigned by the Supervisor in line with Organizational needs.

Required Qualifications and Experience:

1. Bachelor's degree in Social Sciences, Public Health, Environmental Health, Nursing, or a related field.
2. Background or training in nursing, SRH, or MHM is a strong advantage.
3. Experience working in WASH, Health, SRH, or community-based development projects, preferably with youth.
4. Strong reporting, coordination, and communication skills.
5. Willingness to conduct frequent field visits and work with community structures.
6. High level of integrity, teamwork, and commitment to child protection principles.
